

## Guidelines/Manuals: Poor Scholarship

1. Poor scholarship will be provided to one student every year through the poor fund collected from the student fund.
2. The amount of scholarship will be ₹ 3000.
3. Scholarship will be paid through account payee cheque.
4. Qualification: (a) The applicant should belong to BPL category.  
(b) Percentage of marks obtained in the previous class.

Class	Percentage Marks of
For BA 1 <sup>st</sup> year	Percentage marks of class 12
For BA 2 <sup>nd</sup> year	Percentage marks of BA 1 <sup>st</sup> year
For BA 3 <sup>rd</sup> year	Percentage marks for BA 2 <sup>nd</sup> year
For B.Ed and B.P.Ed 1st year	Percentage marks of graduation final year
For B.Ed and B.P.Ed 2nd year	Percentage marks of B.Ed and B.P.Ed 1 <sup>st</sup> year

5. This scholarship will be provided only to those students who are not availing the benefit of any other scholarship.

**Note:** The above guidelines were passed by **the Poor Scholarship Cell of Raath Mahavidyalaya, Paithani** in its meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2017 and approved by the Institute.

## Revised Guidelines/Manuals: Poor Scholarship

1. A total of three scholarships will be provided from session 2021-22.
2. The amount of each scholarship will be ₹ 2000.
3. One scholarship each will be provided separately for B.A., B.Ed. and B.P.Ed.
4. Only first year/first semester students will be eligible for scholarship.
5. Merit will be determined on the basis of percentage of marks obtained in the qualifying examination for admission to the college.
6. Rest of the terms and conditions will remain the same.
